Overview

Children develop ability to feel and match a beat and to construct rhythms following a beat. They develop their recognition of rhythmic notation.

Learning Intentions

Read note values ta titi ta-a sa

Keep a beat accurately counting 1,2,3,4 at different tempii

Echo single 4/4 rhythms to the background of a beat

Read 1 or 2 bars of 4/4 rhythms

A 4-beat rhythm (or 4/4 rhythm) must have 4 beats, according to the following key:
